Official Poppy Pattern



CROCHET PATTERN

You need to make two poppies – one red and the other white.

Use 8ply wool and 4.00mm crochet hook

Require: Black Wool, Red wool, White wool, Green wool and 4mm pearls to finish.

Abbreviations:

ch - chain

sl st – slip stitch

dc – double crochet

RED Poppy

In black

4ch, sl st into 1st ch to form loop, ch2, 11 dc into loop, sl st into 2nd ch, fasten off, change to red.

In red

1st red row - attach anywhere in the circle, ch2, dc into same, (2dc into next) repeat to end, sl st into 2nd ch

2nd red row – ch2, 2dc into same, (3dc into next) repeat to end, sl st into 2nd ch

3rd red row –ch2, , dc into same, (2dc into next) repeat to end, sl st into 2nd ch, fasten off and weave in ends.



White Poppy

In black

4ch, sl st into 1st ch to form loop, ch2, 11 dc into loop, sl st into 2nd ch, fasten off, change to white.

In white

1st white row - attach anywhere in the circle, ch2, 2dc into same, (3dc into next) repeat to end, sl st into 2nd ch

2nd white row - ch2, , dc into same, (2dc into next) repeat to end, sl st into 2nd ch, fasten off and weave in ends.



To finish Peace Poppy

Sew the red and white poppies together with green wool in the centre, sewing stitches in the shape of crocheted stitches – each stitch going through the centre of the poppies.

Finish by sewing the pearls into place, spaced around the middle on the white stitches and one pearl in the centre.
